REVIEWS OF MARKING AND MODERATION (ROMM) – Centres must obtain written consent from a candidate for a clerical re-check and review of marking as candidates marks and grades may be lowered. A review of marking cannot be cancelled once the ROM outcome has been issued by WJEC.

Access to Script	Free access to scripts via the View Script Access page for 6 months following the publication of results. <i>*Centres must obtain written consent to access candidate scripts.</i>	Free	February 2026	N/A

Preliminary Investigation	Appeals must be submitted within 30 calendar days of WJEC issuing the outcome of the ROMM. <i>To appeal, a formal request must be submitted in writing to the Exams Officer, Mrs H Wall, via examsoffice@llanishen.cardiff.sch.uk. Each appeal request will be reviewed by subject leaders and a senior link member of staff on an individual basis prior to the request being sent to the awarding body. The candidate will be notified in writing of the centre's outcome.</i>	£125
Appeal Hearing	A request for a Stage 2 Appeal hearing must be made within two calendar weeks of receipt of the Stage 1 Preliminary investigation appeal outcome letter.	£210
